

7. Guidelines to follow during the 1 on 1 Korean Class

- 1) 1 on 1 Korean class **conducts only the following time** and before starting the class you must set the class schedule with your instructor.
 - **two consecutive hours twice a week between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm on weekdays**
- 2) If you want to **cancel or change the time of the class, you have to contact your teacher 24 hours before each class.** After that you are marked as absent.
- 3) A make-up class **only offers** only the following two situations.
 - ① **Changing your class schedule 24 hours before the class**
 - ② **Changing your class schedule due to the unavoidable circumstances occurred by the instructor**

※ The make-up class only offers during the weekday between 9 am and 6pm.
- 4) If you do **NOT** attend the class **until 10 minutes after the start of class** without prior notice, **you will be marked as absent.**
